

Georgia High School Graduation Test (GHSGT) Georgia High School Writing Test (GHSWT)

Re-Test Pre-Registration Information

Who is eligible to take a re-test of the GHSGT or GHSWT?

Any student currently enrolled in the Ware County School System who has previously failed to meet standard in at least one area of the GHSGT or GHSWT is eligible to take a re-test. Students who have exited Ware County Schools with a Certificate of Performance or a Special Education Diploma are also eligible to take re-tests of the GHSGT or GHSWT.

Who must pre-register to take a re-test administration of the GHSGT or GHSWT?

If you are no longer enrolled as a student in the Ware County Schools, you are expected to pre-register. If you are currently enrolled as a student in the school system you are not required to pre-register. The Graduation Coach and your Guidance Counselor will work with the Site Testing Coordinator to ensure your participation.

When and where are the GHSGT and GHSWT administered?

Re-testers are expected to report to Ware County High School (WCHS) by 8:15 a.m. on the day of testing. Please report to the Main Office and sign in. Testing will take place in Room 1201. Late arrivals may not be allowed to enter the testing room.

Please remember that your cell phone and/or any other electronic devices will be taken up prior to testing and will be released to you when your testing is complete. Allow at least 3 hours for taking parts of the GHSGT and 2 hours for the GHSWT. Students may not be allowed to leave the testing room early as this disturbs other test takers so arrange your schedule accordingly.

What should I bring with me to the testing site?

Anyone not currently enrolled in Ware County Schools should be prepared to present an official picture identification. Those taking the Science or Math portions of the GHSGT may bring a familiar basic function calculator. Everyone should bring at least two #2 pencils.
