

Information You Should Know:

- Students may be dropped off as early as 7:05 am for breakfast. They will be allowed in the hallways at 7:10 am.
- The tardy bell rings at 7:46 am.
- Classes begin promptly at 7:40 am. Please make every effort to ensure that your child is on time for school each day.
- To assist us with a smooth dismissal, do not pull through the bus loading area. If you are picking your child up from school, please be in front of the school at 2:30. You may retrieve your child by pulling through the loading/unloading zone or park and walk up to the building.

Important Information for Car Riders:



If your child will be a car rider this year please note the following guidelines that will assist us in keeping our students safe.

1. All afternoon car riders will be given a “**Dash Card**” for anyone picking up a child to show for identification. Please have the “Dash Card” visible for safety and timeliness purposes.
2. All car riders, both in the morning and afternoon, **MUST** be dropped off and picked up in front of the school. Under no circumstances will a student be allowed to be picked up or dropped off in the back of the school.
3. Please do not drop your child off **before 7:05 am**. There will be **no supervision** for students before that time.
4. When you are dropping your child off, please pull **all the way** to the end of the loading/unloading sidewalk to an **orange cone**. This will allow several cars to drop students off at the same time. Also, do not drop students off in the left hand pull-through lane. This creates a dangerous situation.
5. When you are picking your child up, please **pull through** the loading/unloading circle to a **designated area mark with an orange cone** for your child. As cars in front of you leave, pull forward to the next spot. This will assist in keeping the line moving quickly. There will be staff members in the front of the school to assist the children into their cars.
6. Students **cannot** be picked up from the left hand pull-through lane. You will be asked to pull around and park if you attempt to pick up a student in that lane.
7. Students **are not allowed** to cross the traffic lanes to go to the parking lot. If you drop off or pick up your child in the parking lot, you will have to walk your child across both lanes of traffic onto the sidewalk. Please do not block traffic. If you need to get out of your vehicle for any reason, park in a parking space or along with long sidewalk in front of the building.

We hope that these guidelines will ensure the safety of all of our students.
